

**Sign-up to Trinity College, University of Oxford,
free teacher CPD programme starting in January 2024**

Exclusively for state schoolteachers and colleagues with responsibility for progression, join us for our next programme during which we aim to provide up to date practical information and guidance relating to the Oxford application process and the purpose of each stage, for example, the admissions tests and interviews.

We also have the broader aim of providing teachers and colleagues with guidance that will help them to support their pupils in all higher education applications, as well as those who may have the potential to apply to Oxford.

We particularly welcome colleagues from non-selective state schools who have little or no experience of the University of Oxford, pupil progression to the Russell Group or Higher Education in general.

The programme takes place online and is made up of six 1.5hr live sessions each taking place after the school day. Whilst we begin the programme in January each year, we encourage teachers to join at any point or just for those sessions they would find most helpful. As part of this programme, we also offer a free Teacher Enrichment Residential (details below) which is again completely optional.

We offer a completion certificate for those attending all six online sessions, however there is no requirement to do so. Colleagues are welcome to register and then join for just the preferred sessions.

The 1.5hr twilight sessions include:

1. An introduction to the University of Oxford and the admission process
2. Relevant enrichment activities for all pupils – raising attainment and enhancing future academic success
3. The Personal statement - supporting students through the process
4. The Oxford admissions tests – supporting your pupils to prepare
5. Writing the teacher reference – what high tariff universities are looking for
6. The Oxford academic interview – supporting your pupils to prepare
7. Teacher enrichment residential
